

1993 CHEVROLET CAMERO Z28



In the splendid showroom complex of Colm Dillon Cars in Manorcunningham, Co Donegal, sits a car that is definitely not for sale. And if it were, then it would be far from being the first choice of anyone in pursuit of economy. Colm's show piece is a 1993 Chevrolet Camaro Z28, formerly the official pace car of the 1993 Indianapolis 500 and originally gifted to actress Sally Fields, co-star to Burt Reynolds in the 1977 film 'Smokey and the Bandit'.

The 6.0 litre pushrod V8 produces 275 HP with a massive 441 Nm of torque available, prompting gentle throttle application to keep the rear wheels in line when accelerating.

The 1992 /1993 model was the 4th generation to carry the Camaro badge and was available as a coupé with optional T-top roof like Colm's or as a convertible. The model continued in production until 2002.
